WHAT IS AN INVESTITURE?

Investment is the purchase of an asset with the expectation that it will generate a return over time. The return can be in the form of interest, dividends, or capital gains. The asset can be a physical asset like real estate or a financial asset like a stock or bond. The return is the profit earned from the investment, which is the difference between the purchase price and the selling price, plus any income received during the holding period.

Investment is a key part of wealth creation. It allows individuals to grow their money over time and to diversify their portfolios. The return on investment is a measure of the profitability of the investment, and it is an important factor in determining whether an investment is worth making. The return on investment is calculated as the net profit divided by the initial investment.
