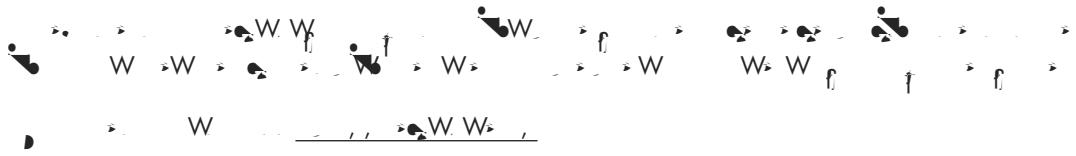

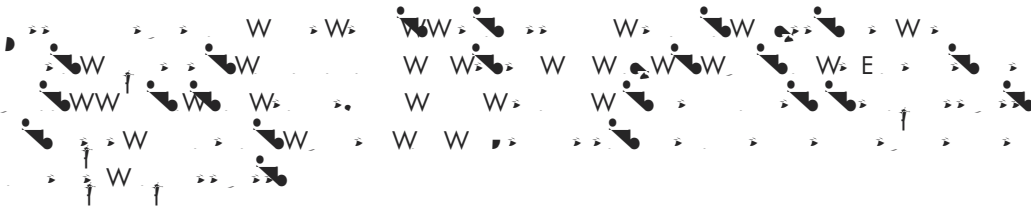

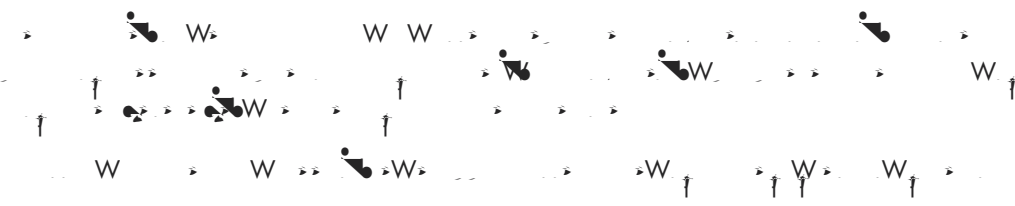
Introduction

DIVERSE AND INCLUSIVE ENVIRONMENT



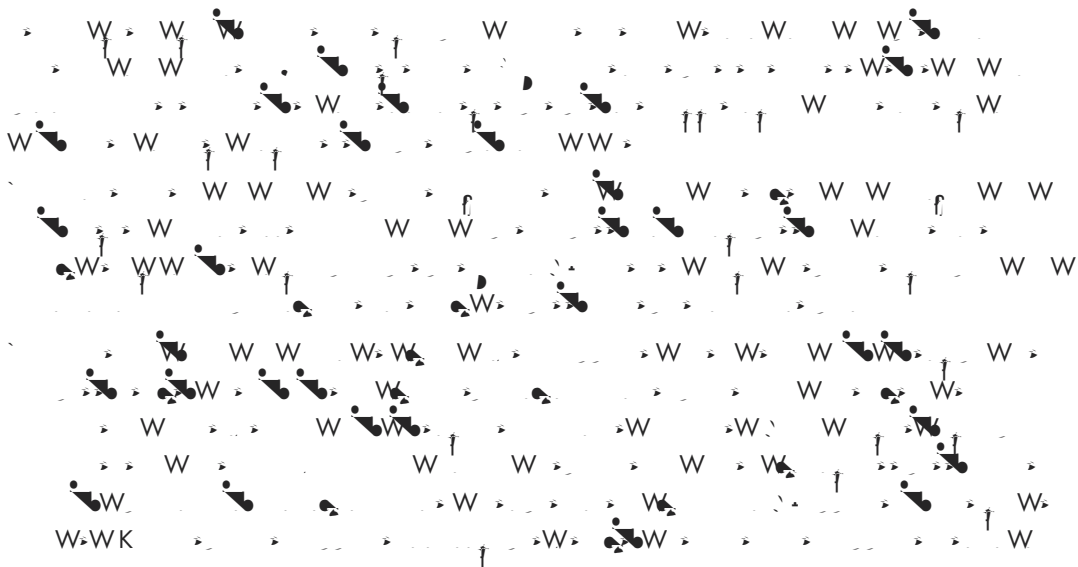
Majorities of students, faculty, staff and alumni agree or strongly agree their institution is committed to ensuring an inclusive environment for all.
